CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND SALE

ENTRY PROCESS

1. Your completed entry form must be received by Daylesford Rotary Club (see contact details on reverse) no later than Friday, 21st October 2011 at 5pm, together with the payment of \$15 per painting (you may enter a maximum of 5 paintings). The entry fee will be refunded only if your paintings are deemed unsuitable for hanging. A receipt for entry fees will be forwarded to you; and
2. All entered paintings must be original works produced and owned by those entering and must be offered for sale at a stated price (including GST) on the form supplied; and
3. All paintings that are for sale must be labelled with your name & painting title & selling price and must be ready for hanging, with wire/cord attached approx ⅓ distance from the top; and
4. The Daylesford Rotary Club may at its sole discretion allow any paintings entered to be photographed and such photographs to be reproduced in Art Show advertising or on the Rotary website
5. We encourage you to provide your profile (up to 200 words) at the time of entry and we will make this available to anyone interested during the Show

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF PAINTINGS

6. Your painting(s) must be delivered in person or by pre-paid courier/representative to the Daylesford Town Hall Art Show reception between 2pm and 5pm on Wednesday, 26th October or between 9am and 12 noon on Thursday 27th October; and
7. Unsold paintings must be collected in person or by pre-paid courier/representative on Monday, 31st October between 4pm & 6pm or Tuesday 1st November between 9am and 12 noon. If your unsold painting(s) are not collected at that time, then you are liable to pay in advance the courier costs of delivering the painting(s) to your postal address within 28 days; and
8. The Daylesford Rotary Club will take all reasonable care of paintings, but will not be responsible for loss, theft or damage to any painting or frame whilst in the Club's possession or in transit or in storage and you are advised to insure your painting(s) against all loss or damage.

ACCEPTABLE PAINTINGS

9. Your painting(s) should have maximum dimensions of 1.25m x 1.00m; and
10. The Daylesford Rotary Club reserves the right of refusal to exhibit paintings which it deems unsuitable for display, in such case the entry payment will be refunded.

PAINTING JUDGING AND SALES

11. The Judging Panel is selected solely by the Daylesford Rotary Club and the judging decisions are final and not subject to review or appeal. The Awards are Best in Show, Best Modern Concept, Best Traditional Style and Best Landscape (max 9"x 5" (23cm x 13cm)) judged solely by the Judging Panel appointed by the Daylesford Rotary Club. The People's Prize is the result of a written popular cash vote by the visitors to the Show. All awards are non-acquisition awards; and
12. A 25% commission based upon the sales amount written on your entry form, or later negotiated with a buyer, will be retained by the Daylesford Rotary Club upon completed sale. Sales are subject to commission until you have departed the Daylesford Town Hall with your paintings in your possession.
