- Providing funds to enhance the work of local groups eg. the Animal Shelter

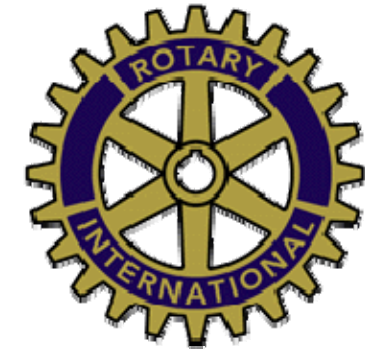
- A Parenting and Numeracy Package for four year olds and their families.
